2 Latter part thick weather with a strong breeze the
4 light came on board and went on shore again also
6 these 2 men came on board their liberty being up
8 gave them another pass and sent them on shore
10 again for 2 days

2 These 24 hours commence with a strong
4 breeze and thick weather
6 Middle part strong breeze and squally

2 Latter part strong breeze commence
4 breaking out oil the mate and one or
6 two more had to appear before the
8 Magistrate on B. F. Hambleton's account
10 he was sentenced with 14 days here
12 labour also have some carpenters
taking off the head knees

2 These 24 hours commence with fine
4 weather employed in hoisting out oil
6 and coopersing it the light came
8 on board &c
10 Middle part fine weather

2 Latter part calm employed in
4 hoisting out oil and coopersing it
6 the light came on board also discharge
8 3 men namely N. Edwards J. Hewarth
10 B. Barr W. Wilcox J. Penney
12 H. Wood H. Loringstone

H. K. F. C. W. S. Remarks Tuesday 11th

2 These 24 hours commence with fine weather
4 and calm one boat crew goes to the boat
6 race the men discharged came on board
8 and got their things
10 Middle part the same

2 Latter part fine weather finish
4 hoisting out oil and coopersing it
6 also have a gang of calkers calking
8 and trying the seams around the carpenters
10 are still taking off the head knees and
12 find her all open under them

H. K. F. C. W. S. Remarks Wednesday 12th

2 These 24 hours commence with light
4 winds and thick weather with some
6 thunder showers got it ready to send
8 on shore
10 Middle part thick weather with a fine
12 rain
2 Latter part fine weather send the oil
4 all on shore in two launches 53 casks
6 and 4 barrels of sperm oil to be sent to
8 London also commence hoisting out the
10 mast
12

H. K. F. C. W. S. Remarks Thursday 13th

2 These 24 hours commence with a fine
4 moderate rain hoist out all of our meat and send
6 all the beef and some of the poorest pork
8 on shore in barrels in all
10 Middle part the same
12
2 Latter part fine weather employed
4 in ships duty also send on shore
6 one barrel of sperm oil storing
8 casks for water
