 Latter part moderate fine weather saw a league to windward on the same track as are also saw the Island of Formosa bearing N 1/2 W

 These 24 hours commence with fine weather finish mending and bent the fore topsail and unbent the main topsail and bent another one also saw Formosa bearing at sundown from N 1/2 W to N also saw two more small islands bearing N 1/2 and N 1/2 E great and little Botell
 Middle part fine weather make 2 or 3 licks & get through Formosa Channel
 Latter part fine pleasant weather saw nothing but the Island of Botell bearing N 1/2 W 10 leagues employed in mending the main topsail
