P.M. took in all but a close reef thin topsail and 3 f Mast staysail with a plenty of thunder and lightning
After part more moderate but very rugged rainy and foggy saw nothing set double reef topsails and jib foresails and main sail &c

At the Mouth of the Straits of Korea H H F C W I Remarks Monday 31st

2 These 24 hours commence with a light breeze and thick weather very rugged &c all sail set saw nothing raining

After part strong breeze and rugged saw at 4 o'clock the land bearing NW 45 miles called Doojae Island near the mouth of the straits of Korea

After part strong breeze and clear weather saw at daylight the sail to leeward and spoke her the Barque Favorite of Fairhaven 38 m on this out 325 sperm Capt. Source bound through the straits
