saw land bearing E and SE at 10 o'clock
Latter part the Island of Osima at noon saw
three Right whale breves but could
not strike them also saw two or three
Japanese junk

2 These 24 hours commence with a strong breeze and
4 light airs saw one 1/2 whale breves but of no
6 value at 4 o'clock half the Island of Osima

some fog saw the land on both sides
Latter part light breeze and fine weather
saw a few porpoises the land and
both sides Nippon and Kesse
