 8 all sail set saw nothing clear weather

 4 topsail
 6 Latter part strong breeze with a
 8 thick snow storm saw nothing
 10 employed in clearing the decks from
 12 snow &c

W. H. F. C. W. L. Remarks Thursday 31st

2 These 24 hours commence with a
 4 strong breeze and rugged but clear
 6 and cool saw at sundown four or
 8 five B whales going to groundward

 2 Middle part light breeze
 4
 6 Latter part light breeze and fine
 8 weather saw 3 or 4 B whales lowered
 10 twice but of no use
 12

W. H. F. C. W. L. Remarks Friday 2nd

2 These 24 hours commence with a calm
 4 and clear weather saw some whales
 6 lowered all four boats and chased them
 8 all the after noon

 8 smart gail took all sail but a last
 10 reef main topsail and fore spencer
 12 saw nothing thick weather &c
