H. H. F. & W. S. Remarks Wednesday 2nd

2 These 24 hours commence with fog
4 at three o'clock ~~it~~ saw five ships
6 to a distance and one *Bolero* more

10 it then dis 6 miles and ice one mile
12 from us the N by E part of the sea of andier
2 Middle part calm and raining saw
4 the Ship *Manerva* with light white
6 take a humpback and cut him in
8 Satter part light air and steady rain
10 saw nothing but ships to a distance
12 No Ws

H. H. F. & W. S. Remarks Friday 4th

2 These 24 hours commence with a light
4 air and steady rain saw and spoke Ship
6 *Atlas*, *Liverpool* and *Caroline* also saw
8 some humpbacks at 4 o'clock P.M. saw one
10 whale going fast also saw boats down from ships
12 to a distance
2 Middle part the same
4 Satter light breeze with some fog at 11 o'clock
6 it cleared of fine saw about 20 ships to a
8 distance the most of them celebrating
10 the fourth of July also saw 2 or 3 humpbacks
12 the land &c

H. H. F. & W. S. Remarks Saturday 5th

2 These 24 hours commence with light
4 airs and calms the ships are still
6 keeping up the fourth saw nothing
8 but ships and land ice &c

4 twelve o'clock
6 Satter part light breeze and fine
8 weather saw nothing but a few
10 plinbacks and ships again
12 with the *Abigail*
