Sunday Oct 3<sup>rd</sup> 1847  
first part Calm and pleasant weather  
General Sail in Light latter part Calm  
and pleasant weather Lat 25° 57' N Long 31° 01' W

Monday October 4<sup>th</sup> 1847  
the day begins with pleasant weather and Calm  
at 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> pm take a Light breeze from S E by E  
latter part Calm and pleasant weather  
all hands employed in fitting Shes and Cu-  
ing blocks Straps Lat 25° 30' N Long 31° 14' west

Tuesday Oct 5<sup>th</sup> 1847  
first part Calm and pleasant Lat part  
Light airs from S W Saw Sail to the westward  
Steering North Lat 25° 00' North

Wednesday Oct 6<sup>th</sup> 1847  
the day begins with moderate breezes from S E W  
with rain latter part fine breezes from S E W  
at 1 pm Saw hills Lat 23° 56' N Long 29° 04' west

Thursday Oct 7<sup>th</sup> 1847 37 days out  
first part Light breezes from S Ship heading  
S E all hands employed tanning in the main  
mizzen latter part Light airs from S  
Lat 23° 04' Long 28° 46'

Friday Oct 8<sup>th</sup> 1847 75  
first part moderate breezes and pleasant  
weather all hands employed at work on the  
main mizzen Saw a Sail to Eastward Steer-  
west latter part Strong breezes from East  
tanned in the fore mizzen Lat 21° 04' N Long 28° 38' west

Saturday Oct 9<sup>th</sup> 1847  
the day begins with pleasant breezes from E  
and fine weather latter part Strong breeze  
from S E Ship heading S by East all hands  
employed in Ship's duty Saw hills  
Lat 18° 50' N Long 27° 29' west

Sunday Oct 10<sup>th</sup> 1847 40 out  
first part Strong breezes from E with fine  
weather Ship heading S by E latter part moderate  
breezes from E S E Ship heading S E by S no  
whales Lat 16° 23' N Long 26° 33'

Monday Oct 11<sup>th</sup> 1847  
first part moderate breezes and pleasant  
weather latter part Strong breezes from  
S E Ship heading S E at 11 am Saw the  
Island of Manu bearing S E distance 20 miles  
Lat by abs 14° 50' N Long 24° 50' west

Tuesday Oct 12<sup>th</sup> 1847  
through the day Light airs and breezes from  
S E Ship heading S by E at 1 pm Spoke  
Ship's penon made S E by S 68 days out one 100  
Spenn latter part moderate breezes and pleasant  
Lat 13° 15' N Long 24° 29' west

Wednesday Oct 13<sup>th</sup> 1847  
I thought the day Light breezes from S E  
Ship heading S E Ship is in Light  
Lat 11° 15' N Long 23° 25' west

Thursday Oct 14<sup>th</sup> 1847  
Through the day equally weather Saw  
black fish and got one Ship is in  
Light got some Iron work  
done S E abs to day
