Through the day moderate breezes from N.W. by W
Course S by the wind Latter part got shales
Lat 46° 20' S Long 56° 57' by 56° 54' 00'

Tuesday Nov 30th 1847
first part moderate breezes from N.W. by W
Latter part Calm no signs of shades
Latter part Lat 47° 36' S Long 5

Wednesday Dec 1 1847
Through the day light airs and pleasant
weather Lat 47° 50' S Long 56° 31' west

Thursday Dec 2 1847
first part Calm and pleasant weather
the water Employed repairing fore top sail
Latter part amoderate breezes from North
Ship Steaming S.W. Lat 48° 10' S Long 57° 31' west

Friday Dec 3rd 1847
Through the day strong breezes from North
and pleasant weather Ship Steaming S.W.
Lat 50° 23' S Long 62° 31' west

Saturday Dec 4 1847
first part strong breezes from N.W. by W
middle part Calm Latter part moderate
breezes from N.W. by S Ship Steaming S.W.
Lat 52° 14' Long 63° 54'

Sunday Dec 5 1847
first part strong breezes from N.W. Ship
heaving S.W. Latter part pleasant weather
at made the Land East end of King
Charles Land and at 4 Lat 54° 08' Long 64° 54'

Monday Dec 6 1847
first part fresh gale from N.W. at 4 Am
Entered the Straits of Le Maire
at 7 passed through them at 9 1/2 Am saw
Shenikote but being dark could not
get him at the same time saw a ship
at 10 took in sail and hove to for the night
at 4 Am made fair stood up our course
Lat 55° 33' S

Tuesday Dec 7 1847
Through the day light breezes from South
to North the Land in sight at 11 1/2 Am
saw Cape Horn bearing N.W. by W wind from
N.W. by W Course S.W. Lat 56° 54' Long 66° 18'

Wednesday Dec 8th 1847
first part pleasant weather at 1 Am
Cape Horn bore west Latter part
heavy at 9 Am saw the bearing
S.W. by S Dist 8 miles at 11 Am wind
landed to S.W. Course N.W. by W by Compass
Lat 56° 21' Long 67° 5'

Thursday Dec 9 1847
first part strong breezes from S.W. Ship
heaving N.W. by W by Compass Latter part strong
gale from N.W. by S at 11 Am made Steadfast
Island bearing S at 12 O.C. Lat 58° 18'
Long 72° 15'
