

Friday Dec 10 1847

Through day Strong gales from west at 5 am
tacked to the Southward tower rock bearing S.W.M.
dist 10 miles Latter part heavy gales from
S.W. at 11 am wore ship to the S.W. at 11 1/2
Set the fore top Sail Lat 54° 07' Long 71° 48'

Saturday Dec 11th 1847

first part Strong gales from W.S.W. ship
heading S.W. by the wind Latter part more
moderate at 6 am saw the Land bearing S.W. with
Sail pinches Lat 55° 23' South

Sunday Dec 12 1847

the day begins with moderate breezes from
W. by S. at 2 am tacked off Thome tower rock
bearing S.W. by S. dist 12 miles Latter part moderate
at 7 am tacked ship to the S.W. and made
Sail Lat 55° 30' S Long 73° 04' west

Monday Dec 13 1847

Through the day Light airs from all quarters
tower in sight Lat 54° 55' Long 74° 01' west

Tuesday Dec 14 1847

first part moderate breezes and pleasant
weather at 5 tacked ship to the S.W.
at 10 pm tacked to the North at 10 am
I saw the Land Lat 54° 51' Long 74° 51'

Wednesday Dec 15 1847

first part Strong gales from west
at 10 am tacked ship to the Southward
Cnapton Island bearing S.W. dist 6 miles
Latter part heavy gales took in the top Sail
and have two under a close reefed main top
Sail and main Spencer and fore topmast stay
Sails Lat by obs 54° 48'

Thursday Dec 16 1847

first part Strong gales from W.S.W.
Ship heading S.W. Latter part more
moderate at 11 1/2 made Sail Lat 54° 07' S

Friday Dec 17 1847

the day begins with moderate breezes from
W.S.W. with pleasant weather at 2 the wind
hauled to the North with thick fog Ship heading
west by Compass Latter part Light winds
Lat 54° 28' S Long 78° 25' west

first part Strong breezes from W.S.W.
middle and Latter parts heavy gales from
west Ship heading S.W. at 11 am wore
Ship to the S.W. Ship under short Sail
Lat by obs 54° 10' S

Sunday Dec 19th 1847

first part heavy gales from W.S.W.
Ship heading S.W. by Compass saw a ship +
steaming to the S.E. Latter part more
moderate Set the top Sails and gill
and main Sail reefed saw a hulk
steaming to the S.E. Lat 52° 01' Long 78° 48'

Monday Dec 20 1847

first part fresh gales from S.W.
Ship heading S.W. by S. Latter part Strong
gales from W.S.W. Lat 49° 19' S

Tuesday Dec 21 1847

first part heavy gales from S.W.
Ship heading S.W. at 2 pm wore ship to
S.W. and reefed the main course at 5 pm
wore ship to the S.W. and reefed fore course
Latter part Strong gales from S.W. at 10
am the ship under S.W. Lat 47° 42' 78° 19'
