

Wednesday Dec 22 1847

first part strong gales from S.W. Ship
steering S.W. by S. Latter part moderate gales
from S.W. Course S.W. by S. Lat 44° 50' Long 78° 03'

Thursday Dec 23 1847

The day begins with fresh breezes from S.W.
Course S.W. at 2 pm saw night whales
Lowered 2 boats with out success at 4 pm the men
went in to the bone castle and found a great
quantity of meat in the punt bucket took it on
deck and weighed it and found it to be 10
pounds in weight Lat 42° 27' Long 78° 00'



Friday Dec 24 1847

Through day strong breezes from S.W. Ship
steering S.W. by S. at 2 pm passed aboys standing
to the South Lat 39° 16' S

Saturday Dec 25 1847

Through the day fine breeze and pleasant
weather but S.W. whales wind from South Course
S.W. Lat 36° 47' S Long 77° 00' west

Sunday Dec 26 1847

first part moderate breezes and pleas weather
wind from S.W. Ship heading S.W. by Compass
Latter part the same saw aboys steering to the
S.W. Lat 34° 31' S Long 77° 55' west

Monday Dec 27 1847

first part fine breezes and pleasant weather
at 3 pm saw Juan P. bearing S.W. by S.
least 50 miles Latter part moderate S.W. wind
went on shore and got a few fish and
one goat so ends the day

Tuesday Dec 28 1847

The day begins with moderate breezes and
pleasant weather at 4 pm Course on board
at 4 1/2 See 2 sails and at 6 1/2 pm saw whales
passed them by 10 pm lowered 3 boats but
saw them no more Latter part moderate
Lat 32° 44' S

Wednesday Dec 29 1847

first part of the 24 hours moderate breezes
and pleasant weather but S.W. whales Latter part
light breezes and pleasant wind from South
Lat 31° 47' S

Thursday Dec 30 1847

Through the day moderate breezes from South
and pleasant weather Lat 30° 2' Long 79° 47'

Friday Dec 31 1847

first part moderate breezes and pleasant
weather Latter part calm and S.W. whales
Lat 28° 30' S Long 79° 47' west

Saturday Jan 1 1848

The day begins with pleasant weather and
calm the watch employed in heaving
down Jap Sails and heaving old ones saw
pink backs whales Latter part calm
Lat 27° 41' Long 80° 49' west

Sunday Jan 2 1848

Through the day light airs from all
quarters at 7 am saw the Island
of St. Helen bearing S.W. by S. distance 65
miles Lat 27° 13' Long 79° 45' west

Monday Jan 3 1848

begins with moderate breezes from S.W. Course
S.W. by S. Latter part employed painting
Ship Lat 25° 41' Long
