Sunday Feb 20 1848
all these 24 hours fine breezes and pleasant
weather and 800 whales Lat 14° 22' S Lat 114° 03'

Monday Feb 21st 1848
first part moderate breezes from
S E employed painting the Cabin
Lat 21 miles S Long

Tuesday Feb 22 1848
through the day fine breezes and pleasant
weather Lat 14° 10' S Long 118° 18' west

Wednesday Feb 23 1848
all these 24 hours strong breezes
employed fitting mizen top mast
back stays Lat 42 miles South

Thursday Feb 24 1848
through the day fine breezes and
pleasant weather Lat

Friday Feb 25 1848
all these 24 hours pleasant weather
and 800 whales Lat 14° 59' S Long 122° 15' west

Saturday Feb 26th 1848
first part moderate breezes and pleasant
weather latter part the same and 800
Spinn Whales Lat 14° 51' S Long 123° 42' W

Sunday Feb 27th 1848
through the day pleasant weather wind from
S E Ship steering from west by S to S W
Lat 14° 15' S Long by Chron 124° 56' by Concom 125° 34'

Monday Feb 28 1848
first part strong breezes Lat a sail
to the Eastward & latter part Spake
Ship onl. at Nantucket 15 minutes
with 900 Spinn Lat 16° S Long 126° 36'

Tuesday March 1 1848
begin with strong breezes and pleasant
weather & Ship in sight and 800 whales
Lat 25 miles South

Wednesday March 1 1848
through the day strong breezes
but 800 whales Lat 16° S

Thursday March 2 1848
all these 24 hours pleasant weather
and 800 Whales Lat 15° S Long 127° 02'

Friday March 3 1848
through the day moderate breezes
and fine weather Lat 15° S Long 128° 30'

Saturday March 4 1848
through the day moderate breezes
and pleasant weather all hands
employed tarring boom rigging
Lat 12 miles S Long 129° 30'
