through the day light breezes and
pleasant weather Ship Steering by the
wind to the S^W Lat 24° 50' Long 178° 58' west

Thursday April 20 1848
first part strong breezes and pleasant
weather at 8 AM Tacked Ship to the South
under easy Sail latter part Tacked to the S^W &
the watch employed in Ship duty
Lat 29° 15' S^W Long by Log 179° 30' west

Friday April 21 1848
through the day moderate breezes from S^W
Ship Steering S^W by compass 870 fms at
whales Lat 30° 55' S^W Long 179° 58' East

Saturday April 22 1848
all these 24 hours moderate breezes and pleas-
ant weather Ship Steering S^W by M Lat 31° 58' S^W

Sunday April 23 1848
through the day moderate breezes from S^W
Ship Steering S^W by M Lat 30° 48' S^W

Monday April 24 1848
through the day moderate breezes from S^W
Ship Steering S^W by the wind 870
whales Lat 30° 41' S^W Long 172° 19' East

Tuesday April 25 1848
through the day moderate breezes and pleasant
weather but 870 whales Lat 30° 43' S^W

Wednesday April 26 1848
all these 24 hours fresh breezes and
cloudy weather Employed repairing mizen
Spencer Lat 30° 58' S^W

Thursday April 27 1848
first part strong breezes from S^W Ship heading
to the S^W and cloudy weather Saw black
fish latter part baffling weather with rain
Saw many Cow fish 870 Obs to Log

Friday April 28 1848
through the day strong breezes from S^W to
S^W Ship heading by the wind to S and west
Saw black fish Lat 30° 30' Long 164° 40'

Saturday April 29 1848
all these 24 hours moderate breezes and
cloudy weather and 870 whales 8 months
out with 150 bls Lat 30° 19' S^W

Sunday April 30 1848
first part moderate breezes and pleasant
weather Ship heading to the westward latter part
very much the same Saw 1 whale 8 months
Lat by obs 30° 46' S^W Long 168° 40' E

Monday May 1st 1848
first part light breezes with pleasant
weather Ship heading to the westward latter
part moderate weather at 6 AM Saw
Spencer Whales going quite to the westward
Lowered all the boats without success Lat 31° 16'

Tuesday 2 1848
first part strong breezes and pleasant
weather latter part the same at
Lat 31° 2' S^W Long 163° 00' E

Wednesday May 3 1848
begins with moderate weather at 6
PM Saw Spencer Whales Lowered
without success Lat 30° 29' S^W
