pleasant weather Lat 29 53 S

Friday May 5 1848  
all these 24 hours pleasant weather  
and 870 whales employed fitting away top  
gallant back stays Lat 29 15 S

Saturday May 6 1848  
Through the day pleasant weather  
and 870 whales and my help Dick  
sent down the main top gallant  
masts to fit the back stays  
Lat 29 44 S Long 163 30 East

Sunday May 7 1848  
all these 24 hours fine weather and 870  
Sperm Whales Ship heading to the Eastward  
Lat 30 44 S Long 164 30 E

Monday May 8 1848  
first part moderate breezes from S E  
Ship steering by the wind to E S and Eastward  
at 2 pm saw 1st to the Southward steering  
to the westward latter part pleasant  
saw 1st back whales but 870 Sperm  
Lat 31 00 S Long 163 09 E

Tuesday May 9 1848  
all these 24 hours moderate breezes  
and pleasant weather Lat 31 52 S

Wednesday May 10 1848  
Through the day pleasant weather and fine  
breezes Ship steering to the S E but 870  
Sperm of whales Lat 30 24 Long 164 52 E

Thursday May 11 1848  
first part moderate breezes from South  
Ship heading to the S E latter part wind  
hauling to S W Ship steering to S E  
Lat 29 26 S

Friday May 12 1848  
Through the day light airs and  
pleasant weather but 870 whales  
Lat 30 28

Saturday May 13 1848  
first part moderate breezes and pleasant  
weather Ship heading to the S W latter  
part light breezes Ship heading to the South  
Lat 30 44 S Long 165 54

Sunday May 14 1848  
Through the day strong breezes from  
S W Ship heading to the S E  
Lat 29 21 S

Monday May 15 1848  
Through the moderate breezes and pleasant  
weather wind from S E Lat 29 00 164 45

Tuesday May 16 1848  
first part fine breezes and pleasant  
weather latter part strong  
breezes from S E Ship heading  
to the westward 870 Sperm of whales  
Lat 29 22 S Long 164 00 by  
Est
