Monday June 16 1848
first part Employed bailing latter
part Employed cleaning ship weather
fine Lat 31°11 N

Tuesday June 20 1848
first part Light breezes and
pleasant weather 12½ pm saw
Spinn whales put up I struck one
and killed him at 4 pm took the
whale to the ship board in chase of
more whales latter part strong
breeze at 6 pm to Lat 31°25 N
saw more whales going quick to the
windward did not lower gun
them at 11½ finished bailing and made
sail Lat 31°08 N



Wednesday 21 1848
first part strong breezes and pleasant
weather at 6 commenced bailing
latter part the same
Lat 31°45 N Long 166°07 E

Thursday June 22 1848
first part Employed bailing latter
part at 8 am finished bailing
commenced cleaning ship
Lat 30°13 N

Friday June 23 1848
first part moderate breezes and pleasant
ship leaving PM latter part calm
& 8½ miles of whales Lat 30°09 N

Saturday June 24 1848
Through day Light airs and fine
weather latter Employed breaching
out the main hatchway Lat 30°37 N

Sunday June 25 1848
Through the day Light airs and
pleasant weather 8½ miles to be
saw Lat 30°57 N Long 167°37 E

Monday June 26 1848
first part moderate breezes and pleasant
weather latter part Employed stowing
saw oil Lat 31°23 N

Tuesday June 27 1848
Through the day Light air fine weather
Employed stowing saw oil at the main
hatch way Lat 30°51 N

Wednesday June 28 1848
Through the day Light airs fine weather
Employed stowing saw oil at 7 pm
finished stowing saw Lat 30°45 N

Thursday June 29 1848
Through the day pleasant weather -
Employed cleaning ship 8½ miles
