

Thursday Aug 24 1848
Through the day Light airs and
pleasant weather. Employed bailing
Lat 32° 05' S

Friday Aug 25 1848
first part moderate breezes
and fine weather at 3 pm
finished bailing. Latter part
strong breezes at 10½ Am Saw
abalone sperm whale lowered
Lat 31° 30' S 172° 40' E



Saturday Aug 26 1848
at 12½ pm lowered for the
whale at 3 pm struck and
killed the whale at 4 pm took
the whale to the ship and cut
1 side of the head at 5 begin
to cut & got head up at 11 Am
Lat 31° 49' finished the body so end the day

Sunday Aug 27 1848
the day begins with strong
breezes at 12½ pm heaved on to
the head at 2 pm commence bailing
at 4½ finished bailing the Cais
Latter part Employed bailing
Lat 31° 42' 17° 30' E 172° 30'

Monday Aug 28 1848
Through the day Employed
bailing at 8 pm Equalled baron
at 4 Am commence again
Lat 31° 26' S

Tuesday Aug 29 1848
first part Employed bailing latter
part generally weather at 6 Am finished
bailing at 4 Am Saw sperm whales
at 10 Am lowered so end the day



Wednesday 30 1848
at 2½ pm the B Boat fastened
to a small whale and soon
struck and killed
the same whale at 4 pm
took the whale to the ship and
started same side down in the
bld room at 5 begin to cut
at 9 finished 1½ Saw more
sperm whales. Lowered without
success the day ends in strong
gales with rain



Thursday Aug 31 1848
first part strong gales of
from South with rain latter
part Employed bailing at 5 Am
Saw sperm whales going quick
to windward did not lower for
them Lat 32° 37' S



Friday Sept 1st 1848
first part strong breezes and
gales from S with rain Employed
bailing at 8 pm started bailing
latter part heavy gales at 5 pm
begin to bail so end the day

Ground up sperm 100 blbls

1 half of the whale Ground up 45 blbls
