Through the day Squally weather
with rain bent a new fore top sail
for a maine top sail to replace the
old one hauled away the back
sails of the main sail in rent it
and put on new back ropes as to day

Monday March 19 1849
First part Squally weather
with rain bent fore topmast stay sail
and bent a new one to make the old
one to replace the fore and main
top sails Ship Abigail in sight
Latter part Squally weather
Lat 2° 04' N Long 167° 08' W

Tuesday March 20 1849
First part moderate breezes from
SSE Ship heading to westward
in bent the old fore topmast stay
sail and bent a new one Latter
part Employed repairing main
top sail Ship in sight
Lat 2° 16' N Long 166° 46' W

Wednesday March 21 1849
Through day Squally weather
Lat 2° 21' N 167° 04' W

Through the day light
with cloudy weather
Lat 2° 21' N 167° 04' W

Thursday March 22 1849
Through the day calm all Employed
mending sails and painting Cabin
Lat 2° 30' N 168° 30' W

Saturday March 24 1849
Through the day Calm all hands
Employed painting Cabin and waist
and bow boats at 11 AM Capt young
and Lady and Child came on board
and spent the afternoon
Lat 3° 29' N

Sunday March 25 1849
Through the day Calm and fine
weather Ship Abigail in sight
Lat 4° 20' N Long 166° 30' W

Monday March 26 1849
Through the day fine weather
with a light breeze from SE
Latter part Employed stowing
down sail Lat 5° 02' N 166° 31' W

Tuesday March 27 1849
First part fine weather
with light wind from SE
Latter part mending finished stowing
down sail as to day

Wednesday March 28 1849
First part rainy weather Employed
gating out shrouds for water
Latter part Employed clearing
Ship wind from SE Course W by N
Cloudy weather Lat 6° 22' N 166° 37' W

Thursday March 29 1849
First part Squally weather
wind from SSE Course west by
Samp. Latter part fine weather
Took the 2 pumps on deck and cleaned
the Libbers Lat 6° 48' N 162° 47' W
