

Friday March 30 1849

first part of the 24 hours fine weather with pleasant breezes from ESE Ship steering west by compass the watch employed getting up shanties and other jobs of ship duty at 4 1/2 pm spoke ship Abigail young latter part strong breezes from ESE Lat 6 50 160 30

Saturday March 31 1849

first part strong breezes from ESE Ship steering N by compass at 4 am made Wellington Island in Lat 6 32 Long 159 52 E at 5 half off to WSW under short sail all night at 5 am heeled up west & W under all lowering sail latter part moderate breezes and fine weather Lat 6 46 S 159 5

Sunday April 1 1849

first part moderate breezes and fine weather at 7 am made Keenison at 11 am went in with the boat at noon returned to ship latter part laying up and on at 5 pm went in with the boat at 8 pm returned to the ship and at 8 am passed neeb at 5 1/2 am came to anchor in 5 fathoms water with the Best Bower 30 fathoms & Galle at 9 sent 22 Casks for water and Carabineer cleaning ship

Monday April 23 1849

at 4 am got under way to wander out of the harbor at 10 am passed through the 2 neeps and stood to sea sent in 2 boats to ship Abigail at 3 1/2 got the Abigail out

Tuesday April 24 1849

through the day laying up and on for yams and so forth

Wednesday April 25 1849

through the day employed getting yams ship Abigail in sight on in company so ends the day

Thursday April 26 1849

the day begins with squally weather at 3 am finish mending and put a way at 4 am saw sperm whales lowered 2 boats struck and killed a small whale took him to ship and stood off shore to the south ward at 3 am reached ship at 5 1/2 am took the whale to ship Abigail as my own eating falls were as none at 7 am saw more sperm whales lowered 2 boats at 10 struck and killed a small whale 184 41 Lat 2 50 Ends the day Lat 6 21 S

Friday April 27 1849

at 2 pm took the whale to ship Abigail and cut him in at 6 pm pilled away to the ESE latter part squally weather ship heading to the Eastward ship employed hoisting No abt to day
