first part strong breeze
Leaving 8:30 M by the wind the watch
employed painting the 2 quarter boats
Latter part employed braiding out
the bread Lat 27° 19' Long 154° 58' E

Wednesday May 10 1849
first part strong breeze from
S.E. Ship heading S.E. by the wind
Ship Abigail in sight. Latter
part strong breeze and cloudy
weather. Saw many birds
Lat 23° 14' S Long 154° 46' E

Thursday May 11 1849
Through the day strong breeze
from S.E. Ship heading S by the wind
Lat 24° 57' S

Friday May 12 1849
Through the day strong
breeze from S.E. Ship heading by
the wind to the Southward
Lat 26° 19' Long 155° 18'

Saturday May 13 1849
Through the day strong breeze
at 10 Spoke Ship Abigail
Lat 28° 19' Long by Chron 155° 31' E
by Lines 155° 31' E

Sunday May 14 1849
first part moderate breeze
and fine weather. Latter part
moderate breeze and fine weather.
Ship heading S.E. by E by Compass
Lat 29° 57' S Long 156° 47' E

Tuesday May 15 1849
Through the day moderate breeze
at 3 PM Spoke Ship Abigail
and Lat 30° 11' up point at 18.00
Latter part light airs S.W. Sings
of whales Lat 30° 31' S

Wednesday May 16 1849
first part employed cleaning
Ship. Latter part employed
painting the masts and water
ways Lat 31° 25' Long by Chron 158° 22' E
by Lines 158° 12' E

Thursday May 17 1849
first part employed painting
masts light and fine weather
Latter part the same Ship Abigail
in sight to the seaward Lat 32° 02' S

Friday May 18 1849
Through the day moderate breeze
from South Ship heading from S.W. E
at 6 AM Spoke Ship Abigail Steering S.W.
Lat 32° 12' S Long 161° 19' E

Saturday May 19 1849
the day begins with moderate breeze
and fine weather at 1 PM absent the
hull of the ship and sent a crew and
two jammers but S.W. sperm whales
Latter part rainy weather
S.W. all the day

Sunday May 20 1849
Through the day moderate breeze
and fine weather Ship Abigail
in sight Saw many fin backs
whales Lat 30° 14' Long 163° 14' E
