Monday July 16 1849
Through the day moderate winds
with fine weather Lat 30°32 167°00
at 6 AM Saw Sperm whales and
at 7 Landed at 8 the Standard
165 57. Struck and killed whale at 8:00 AM
J.B. took the whale to Ship Lat 30°50



Tuesday July 17 1849
at 12½ AM hooked on to the whale
at 5 got the body in and hooked on
to the head Latter part Employed
bailing water fine Lat 30°19 S

Wednesday July 18 1849
Through the day Employed Bail
Lat 30°40 S

Thursday July 19 1849
Through the day moderate breezes
and fine weather Lat 30°50

Friday July 20 1849
first part Employed Crapery
oil Latter part had a sail
to Westward at 8 AM Saw
Sperm whales hawered with art
Success Lat 30°45 166°50

Saturday July 21 1849
Through the day Employed
Hauling down oil in the fore
reach Lat 30°19

Sunday July 22 1849
Through the day Calm and 8:10
whales Spoke Ship Almirante
Captaining Master 24 months out
750 Sperm had spoken the ship
in June 650 Sperm Lat 30°14 S

Monday July 23 1849
first part moderate breezes and fine
weather Latter part Employed
Hauling down oil 8:10 Signs of whales
Lat 30°46 Long 166°19 East

Tuesday July 24 1849
first part Employed Hauling all
the afternoon with 8:10 Signs
of whales Latter part finished
Lat 30°40 S

Wednesday July 25 1849
Through the day light winds from
the Southward Lat 31°22 S

Thursday July 26 1849
first part Calm and pleasant
Latter part rainy Lat 30°48 167°45 E

Friday July 27 1849
Through the day moderate breezes
and fine weather Lat 30°22

Saturday July 28 1849
Through the day moderate breezes
and fine weather Lat 30°40 166°20

Sunday July 29 1849
all these 24 hours fine weather
Lat 31°33 S Long 167°15 E
