SE at 6 pm made heading SW
latter part made men employed
beating up the land so ends the day

Monday Oct 29 1849
first part strong gale
at 10 AM came to anchor
at Lahaina in 14 fathoms water
noon

Tuesday Nov 1 1849
at 4 pm got under way at
Lahaina at with 23 men on
board in all and

Thursday Nov 22 1849
at 12½ left the ship and went
on shore at wharve at 3 landed
at ½ got on board and put
away for Astoria at latter part
calm ahead in sight so ends the day

Friday Nov 23 1849
through the day calm Astoria in
sight so ends the day

Saturday Nov 24 1849
first part moderate breezes
latter part at 6 AM landed at Astoria
and begin to unload so ends the day

Sunday Nov 25 1849
at 2 AM got up 20 bbls potatoes
and at 5 finished unloading got up
32 bbls potatoes and 1800 oranges some
paul and few Yumbers at 6 AM filled
away and stood off shore so ends the day

Monday Nov 26 1849
first part moderate breezes from SE
Ship heading SW by the wind latter part
made the ground Lat 24 44 S

Tuesday Nov 27 1849
through the day moderate breezes
Ship heading by the wind to Southward
Lat 19 00 S Long 159 00

Wednesday Nov 28 1849
first part strong winds Ship
heading SE latter part strong breezes
and heavy swell on at 6 AM came away
the fore top mast and head up main
top gallant mast all hands employed
cleaning away the mast and rigging and
making ready to send up and on
so ends the day

Thursday Nov 29 1849
through the day strong winds
wind all hands employed putting away
fore top mast at 10 AM came to
main top sail and went down on
Lat 15 27 S Long 157 48 W

Friday Nov 30 1849
through the day strong breezes
at 10 AM sent up fore top mast
Lat 13 50 S

Saturday Dec 1 1849
through the day strong breezes
sent up the fore top gallant mast
and yard 3 Ship in sight
Lat 11 50 S
