Through the bay strong breezes  
Ship steaming S.E. by S 3 ships in  
sight latter part many rocks to bay

Monday Dec 3 1849

Through the bay squally weather and rain  
3 ships in sight no abs to bay

Tuesday Dec 4 1849

Through the bay rainy weather  
no abs to bay

Wednesday Dec 5 1849

first part squally weather  
latter part at 11 AM took the  
grades wind ship heading to S.W.  
Lat 7 25 N Long 158 15 W

Thursday Dec 6 1849

Through bay fine breezes from  
the S.E. ship heading S.W. by the wind  
L B Lat 5 45 N Long 159 38 West



Friday Dec 7 1849

Through the bay strong breezes and  
at 6 AM saw sperm whales bowled  
at 11 the starboard and L boats  
struck the S.B. boats line parted  
so lost the whale Lat 34 45 N  
Long 160 14 W



Saturday Dec 8 1849

The first part at 2 rushed on to  
the whale at 3:30 passed latter part moderate  
breezes at 6 AM saw sperm  
whales banded struck and killed 3 small  
ones at 11 AM took the whales to the  
ship Lat 4 55 N Long 160 19 W

Sunday Dec 9 1849

at 2 began to cut at 5 PM finished  
and began to boil latter part strong breezes  
and fine weather Lat 4 40 N Long 160 06 W

Monday Dec 10 1849

first part moderate breezes and fine  
weather employed boiling one man sick  
app only latter part strong breezes  
and fine weather Lat 4 56 N Long 160 10 W

Tuesday Dec 11 1849

first part employed boiling at 11 PM  
begin to rain with heavy squalls  
latter part fine weather and a light  
breeze from S.E. Lat 4 56 S 160 140 N

Wednesday Dec 12 1849

Through the bay moderate breezes and  
fine weather Lat 3 44 N

Thursday Dec 13 1849

Through the bay moderate breezes  
from S.E. ship heading by the wind  
to the S.W. Lat 2 20 N 161 00 W

Friday Dec 14 1849

Through the bay strong breezes  
and fine weather Lat 1 44 N

Saturday Dec 15 1849

all the day breezes moderate  
wind Lat 00 30 S 161 152 W
