all the day strong winds

Through the day moderate winds
from 818 ship landed to the westward

Wednesday Dec 26 1849
all the 24 hours light airs
Lat 0° 30' S Long 174° 10' W

Through the day moderate winds
and fine weather Lat 0° 20' S

Friday Dec 28 1849

Monday Jan 1 1850
first part moderate winds all
hands employed in the boats up the
ship. latter part much the same

years here at least but better for
me but I hope it is over the year

days that years is out of the question
