for the Arctic Ocean
Lat 15° 29' S Long 156° 54' E

Wednesday April 10 1850
first part moderate breezes and fine weather
at 2 o'clock Ship gen. Scott latter
part moderate S.W. gale of sperm whales
seen Lat 17° 25' Long 157° 30' E

Through the day moderate breezes
from E & E Ship heading to the S
Lat 19° 18' S Long 158° 50'

Friday April 12 1850
Through day strong breezes and fine
weather Ship heading to the South
Ship gen. Scott in Company
Lat 21° 19' Long 157° 56' E

Saturday April 13 1850
Through the day in strong breezes
Ship gen. Scott in Company
Lat 23° 04' Long 158° 00'

Sunday April 14 1850
first part moderate winds from S & E 15 m
latter part wind from E Lat 25° 09'

Monday April 15 1850
Through the day moderate breezes
and fine weather my self sick and
saw large of whales Lat 26° 49' S

Tuesday April 16 1850
Through the day moderate breezes and fine
weather Lat 28° 22' S Long 158° 21' E

Wednesday April 17 1850
Through the day moderate breezes and fine
weather at 5 PM saw a shoal of sperm
whales lowered 3 boats without success
Lat 28° 17' S Long 158° 00' E

Thursday April 18 1850
Through the employed repairing fore sail
and main & topsails Ship gen. Scott
in Company Lat 28° 55' S

Friday April 19 1850
Through the day moderate breezes and
fine weather saw sperm whales
Lat 29° 43' S Long 158° 16' E

Saturday April 20 1850
all the day strong breezes
from the S.W. Ship heading to the E
Lat 30° 13' Long 161° 00' E
