

June 1 1880 Saturday  
Sailed with strong breeze from East  
Ship heading west by N 80  
miles latter part the same Isaac Ellis  
up party with clap boat 31<sup>m</sup> 27<sup>h</sup> 8<sup>m</sup>

Sunday June 2 1850.  
Through the day moderate breezes and  
fine weather. No signs of whales here.  
Lat. 32 09 N. 168 30.

Monday June 3 1850  
first part moderate breezes and  
fine weather Ship heading to the SW and  
may God direct me to find whales for  
I am heart sick of my situation  
Lat 32° 04' 168° 01' E

Tuesday June 4 1870  
the day being moderate breezes and fine  
weather Ship heading to SW & whales  
to be found Lat 31 56 Long 167 30 E

Wednesday June 18<sup>th</sup> 1870.  
Through bay moderate breeze and fine  
weather 870 whales here Lat 31°30'

Thursday June 6 1850  
all the 24 hours light airs from  
E Ship heading SW Lat 30° 47' 28"

Sunday June 7 1850  
Through the day calm 800 fathoms  
up wheels Lat 30° 46' Long 165° 00' E

Saturday June 8 1860  
first part calm & waves to be  
seen latter part calm  
Lat 31° 45' 166° 10' E

Sunday June 9 1850  
all the day Lewis calm and fine weather  
but the whaler LAT 30° 28' 28" 164° 16'

Maunday June 10 1850  
Through the heavy calm and squalls  
up whales unboast the mizen partail  
and repaired it Lat 30 02 S 164 10 E

Tuesday June 11 1870  
 frost sent moderate breezes from west  
 weather fine No Spanish whales to  
 be seen Lat 30 00 163 130 3

Wednesday June 12 1890  
 Strong at day moderate cool and  
 fine weather Lat. 29.29 161.08

Thursday June 13 1850  
Through the day moderate wind and  
weather but 2 P.M. 16° 27° &

Aniakchag June 14 1870  
Through the day I remained under  
from E. E. Ship leaving west by the  
Camp at Lat 51 08. Long 158 04 E

Saturday June 15 1850  
all the 24 bags strong winds from  
South Lat 31 148 Long 161 00  
to day I have nasal same blood from  
my stomach and lost 1 ounce to supper

all the 24 hours showing considerable number of  
Ba whales to be seen and my self sick  
I have naved more blood from my stomach  
Lat 32 05 N Long 16

not as I think we have met again  
 yet I have always large notions of I shall  
 mean 'some' some with all with me. I never mean
