Shading to the S and to NE Saw Black
fish Lat 30 50 Long 171 19 E

 Monday July 15 1850
first part moderate winds and fine weather
at 5 pm Saw Sperm whales Lowered 3 Boats
without success the night calm at 7 am
Saw more Sperm whales Lowered at 11 am
the Harbours B. Grue and killed a large
whale 500 lbs the day No obs to day
171 00 4 S E

 Tuesday July 16 1850
Began with fine weather 3 Boats in Chaise
of the whales at 1 pm the S Boat Grue
and killed a whale at 12 pm Grue one
of the whales to Ship at 4 Grue the other
whale to Ship at 5 Commence cutting at
7 got 30 one of the whale and set the
net. Latter part fine weather at 6 looked
and Grue in the head and cleared it away.

Wednesday July 17 1850
first part fine weather at 1 pm looked on
at 4 got all in got 200 and set the
net. Latter part fine weather Employed
Boiling Saw billers all hands on duty
Lat 30 54 Long 170 30 E

Thursday July 18 1850
the day begins with light airs and fine
weather Employed Boiling Lat 31 16 S

Friday July 19 1850
first part calm weather fine Employed
boiling at 2 pm finished Boiling all except
the lean at 5 finished all a light breeze
from NW Ship heading to the East
Latter part Employed Coping oil
Lat 30 48 Long 170 18 E

first part Employed Coping oil
wind light from NE Ship heading to the
NE Latter part Employed Stowing down
oil in the Starboard Side of the after
hold one man on duty with a lone
boat Lat 30 48 S

Saturday July 21 1850
first part moderate winds from E Ship heading
to the South Latter part fine weather and no
whales Lat 30 01 S Long 170 30 E

Sunday July 22 1850
first part. Squally weather Ship heading
to the South Latter part Employed Stowing
down oil in the S Side of the after hatch
Lat 29 17

Monday July 23 1850
first part Employed Stowing down oil
at 4 pm finished 3 whales 206 bls 15 gals
Latter part Stowing wind from E
Lat 29 48 170 15 E

Tuesday July 24 1850
all the 24 hours Stowing breezes from
E Ship Steering to Lat 30 53 169 00
