

Thursday July 25 1850
Though the day moderate winds from
E Ship steering to the westward 810 signs
of whales here Lat 29° 52' 168° 30' E

Friday July 26 1850
Though the day strong winds from E
Ship heading to the Southward at 9 AM
Saw sperm whales going much to the
wardward lowered 3 boats without success
Lat 31° 15'

Saturday July 27 1850
first part strong breezes from E & S E
Ship heading to the South at 4 1/2 pm
Saw more sperm whales lowered and
struck and killed one 40 lb whale
at 5 1/2. Took the whale to ship and
took in sail and made all fast
from the night latter part strong wind
from E at 5 AM began to cut at 5:10 finished
168° 18' 31° 15' S Lat 31° 15' S 167° 55' E

Sunday July 28 1850
Though the day employed boiling strong
winds from E & S E Saw breachers supposed
to be sperm whales Lat 31° 01' S

Tuesday July 29 1850
first part strong breezes at 4 1/2 pm
Saw sperm whales close to the ship lowered
without success at 7 returned on board
latter part strong breezes from
E at 8 AM Saw sperm whales
lowered all the boats & boat struck
and killed a small whale the other boats
in chase of the whales
No abs to day

Wednesday July 30 1850
the day began with moderate breezes and fine
weather at 1 PM took the whale to ship
at 2 1/2 all the returned on board at 3 began
to cut at 6 finished latter part fine weather
at 8 AM began to build Lat 30° 50' 167° 30'

Thursday July 31 1850
Though the day the same as stated in the
day above Lat 30° 02' 167° 11' E

Friday Aug 1 1850
Though the day moderate winds from E
Employed boiling Lat 31° 08' 167° 10'

Saturday Aug 2 1850
first part calm and pleasant weather
Employed cleaning ship latter part
Employed capering of oil Lat 31° 31' S

Sunday Aug 3 1850
Though the day moderate winds from
S & E Ship heading in to the S Lat 31° 34'

Monday Aug 4 1850
first part moderate winds and cloudy
weather Ship heading to E & S E latter part
strong gales from South Ship heading
E by S Lat 32° 01' latter part moderate breeze

Tuesday July 5 1850
Though the day strong wind from South
Ship heading E Lat 31° 50' S

Wednesday Aug 6 1850
Though the day moderate weather
Lat 31° 35' 170° 15' E
