No signs of whales Lat 35 22

Friday Sept 27 1850
Through the day moderate winds and
fine weather Employed painting ship
Lat 31° 52' S 178° 28'

Saturday Sept 28 1850
all the 24 hours fine weather
wind from ESE Ship heading to the
SE all hands Employed painting
ship Lat 31 15 177° 49' E

Sunday Sept 29 1850
all the 24 hours Showy winds from E
Ship heading SE Lat 31° 00' S 178 15'

Monday Sept 30 1850
Through the day moderate breeze and
fine weather Lat 31° 08' 178° 50' E

Tuesday 1st 1850
first part Showy gale from East Ship
heading SE by the wind aheady sweep on
Latter part more moderate
but No signs of whales Lat 31° 06' S

Through the day Showy
winds from the ESE No signs of whales
& more down with the Showy
Lat 31° 40' S
