

Friday Oct 18 1850

first part fresh breezes from S^WE Ship steering
E^SE 1 Ship in sight none were flying Jib Hall
beant the main Jap fair forward latter part
moderate wind from East Ship heading E^SE
Lat 32 23 Long 160 00 W

Saturday Oct 19 1850

first part light wind from E^SE wind fine weather
1 Ship in sight none were Home braces
later part light wind from SE Ship heading
South by the wind Lat 31 25 S Long 161 46 by
Chronometer 159 46 by Lunar obs

Sunday Oct 20 1850

first part light air the ship heading South by
my self sick and but little prospect of getting
to port soon later part a light air from SE
Lat 30 56 S Long 161 49 by Chronometer

Monday Oct 21 1850

first part fine breezes from S^WE
Ship heading E^SE latter part strong
gale from S to west Ship steering E^SE
Lat 30 18 Longitude 159 45 W

Tuesday Oct 22 1850

first part strong gale and squally weather
at 6 p m wind lullid to the S^WE
latter part strong wind
Lat 29 18 Long 157 46 W

Wednesday Oct 23 1850

through the day strong wind from
S^WE Ship steering S by E Lat
Lat 27 30 Long 156 46 west

Thursday Oct 24 1850

through the day moderate wind from
S^WE Ship steering South by E
Lat 24 36 S Long 155 30 W

Friday Oct 25 1850

through the day moderate wind from S^WE
Ship steering S by W Lat 22 36 S 155 30

Saturday Oct 26 1850

first part strong wind from E^SE
Ship steering SW at 5 AM made
Lahaina at seven entered the passage
at 5 PM came to anchor at main
in 11 fathoms water 3 men leaved
with the Jemmy

Sunday Nov 19 1850

at 6 PM broke our anchor and
steered for ahead at 5 called ahead
of the Jemmy at 4 went on shore
to land the day

Wednesday Nov 20 1850

at 5 PM got on board and
lay up all night at 6 put
away our stores to 21 19 21

Thursday Nov 21 1850

all the 24 hours strong wind from
S^WE Ship steering from about four points
at seven called ahead of the harbor
to land the day

Friday Nov 22 1850

at 12 1/2 PM landed 1 boat and went
on shore got 34 lbs of potatoes 900 oranges
at 6 PM finished loading and came
