

Sunday June 5 1851
the day came in with strong breezes
and fine weather at 1 pm hauled
up the whales at 4 finished cutting
and got the sea and set the
water and began to sail latter part
moderate winds Employed Boiling Saw
3 sail steering the Eastward Lat 29° 18'

Monday June 9 1851
first part Employed Boiling Saw sail
to westward latter part fine weather all hands
Employed trying out and cleaning ship
Lat 29° 55' S Long 40° 43' west

Tuesday June 10 1851
first part moderate breezes and fine weather
wind from South Ship steering S by E at 1 pm
Saw sail steering to the NW saw a breach
try whales turned up 68 lbs latter part moderate
winds and fine weather Ship steering S by E
Lat 30° 52' S

Wednesday June 11 1851
Through the day moderate wind fine
weather but no whales Lat 31° 03'

Thursday June 12 1851
Through the day moderate wind
and fine weather Stowed down 63 lbs 21 g
up sail Lat 32° 05' Long 40° 20' west

Friday June 13 1851
Through the day moderate winds and
fine weather Employed cleaning ship
and getting ready for painting and so forth
Lat 32° 05' S
Long 43° 21' west

Saturday June 13 1851
first part light breezes from S & E Ship steering
N by S all hands Employed in painting ship latter
part the same saw hump backs whales but
did not lower for them and but a small
prospect of sperm whales here Lat 31° 29' S

Sunday June 14 1851
Through the day moderate winds fine weather
Ship steering N by E by compass saw signs whales
Lat 31° 43' S Long 46° 35' west

Monday June 15 1851
first part moderate winds and fine weather
Ship steering N by E by compass latter part
fine weather spoke in the 3 g sails
and flying sail Lat 32° 09' S 47° 10'

Tuesday June 16 1851
first part strong breezes and fine
weather at 1 1/2 pm saw sperm whales
at 3 lowered anchor and bill 1 long
one at 6 made the whale to the ship
and made in sail and got the water
latter part Employed cutting at noon finish
JB  Lat 32° 11' S 48° 50'

Wednesday June 17 1851
Through the day Employed Boiling Saw sail
at 10 pm spoke ship 2 whales S by E
25 day out to sperm oil Lat 31° 58'

Thursday June 18 1851
Through the day moderate weather but
no sperm whales saw a whale steering to the
Eastward saw a hammer finished Boiling
the water Employed cleaning ship
Lat 31° 58' S Long
