Remarks on Boera Ship, No. 1

Friday Jan 14th This day commenced squally galling ship too under reef main & sail and fore sail at 6 the Boat came on board middle squally last squally broke out clear and reefed main & sails of oil the ship in sight and a Bagua Saenda Land in sight

Saturday Jan 15th This day commenced with a fine breeze employed in stowing the oil down at 4 galled with the Columbus 2 sails in sight and Land middle squally last sent down the fore & sail and mending it Saenda.
Lat 3.12 S Long 175.17 E

Sunday Jan 16th This day commenced with a strong breeze employed in mending the top sail at 4 bent it and wet the oil middle squally last strong breeze Saenda.
Lat 3.30 S Long 175.10 E

Monday Jan 17th This day commenced with a strong breeze middle squally and blowing a gale last blowing a gale and rain Saenda.

Tuesday Jan 18th This day commenced with a gale took in fore & main top sails and hard rain middle rain last strong breeze Saenda.
Lat 3.18 S Long 175.23 E

Wednesday Jan 19th This day commenced with a strong breeze employed in ship last middle rain last revised whales lower a very reef Saenda.
Lat 3.30 S Long 175.30 E

Thursday Jan 20th This day commenced with a strong breeze off chasing whales the B Boat struck at 4 took in a long side middle getting ready to cut last employed in cutting a sail in sight Saenda.
