Remarks on board Wednesday Sept 6<sup>th</sup>  
This day commenced with light  
breezes from S.W. beating out at 3 P.M.  
the Pilot left stowed the anchors and  
cables and made things snug for the  
night at 7 P.M. no man's Land bearing  
E by S. ship heading S.E. wind light  
from S.W. a strong easterly current  
middle part light breezes from S.W.  
steering S.E. by S. latter part light from  
S.W. heading S.E. all hands employed  
in fitting boats saw a ship steering W  
sounds three 24 hours. Lat 40.29 N  
Long 69 27 W

Remarks on board Thursday Sept 7<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with light breezes from S.W.  
heading S.E. at 12 P.M. tacked ship heading S.W.  
at 1 P.M. ship heading S by E winds light and  
baffling all hands employed in fitting boats  
middle part strong breeze from S.W.  
steering S.E. by S. took in light sails and  
reefed top sails latter part light from  
W.N.W. made all sail all hands employed  
in fitting boats sounds three 24 hours.

Commenced with light breezes from S.W.  
steering S.E. employed in fitting boats  
saw a sail steering S. night part light  
S.W. steering S.E. latter part light

Remarks on board Saturday Sept 9<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with light breezes from  
S.W. steering S.E. employed in taking  
out water and cutting pendents. middle  
part fresh breezes from S.E. steering  
S.E. latter part fresh breeze employed  
in taking out evening pendents sounds  
three 24 hours. Lat 37.12 N  
Long 62.20 W

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 10<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. by W  
steering S.E. employed in taking out  
cutting pendents found them after a long  
search at night took in light sails  
middle part strong breeze reefed top sails  
latter part light from S.E. heading S.E.  
made all sail sounds three 24 hours

Remarks on board Monday Sept 11<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with light breezes from S.E.  
heading S.E. saw a Finback whale  
middle part light from E heading S.E.  
latter part light employed in taking  
cutting pendents and fitting rigging
