 Commenced with a gale from N.E. by E. lying to
 under. Close reef main Tapsail at 4 wind
 hauled in to beat moderate set fore sail
 shook one reef out main Tapsail. Middle part
 moderate made set fore top sail. Latter fresh
 breezes. from W steering E sounds these 24
 hours Lat-33° 33' S Long 1° 27' E

Remarks on board Thursday Dec 7th
 Commenced with fresh breezes from W steering
 E Employed in making mates at 4 put out
 Bow Boat saw Fin Backs middle part light
 breezes from W steering E Latter light at 10
 am saw a whight whale toward two
 Boats and struck him sounds these 24
 hours Lat-33° 38' S Long 2° 40' E

Remarks on board Friday Dec 8th
 Commenced with light breezes and fine
 weather at 4 P.M. took the whale. a long side
 Commenced cutting at dark lashed down for
 the night middle part fine Latter the same
 finished cutting and commenced boiling
 sounds these 24 hours Lat-33° 32' S
 Long 3° 06' E

Remarks on board Saturday Dec 9th
 Commenced with light breezes from N
 steering E Employed in boiling brake out
 meat saw plenty of Fin backs middle part
 light rains Latter fine weather Employed
 in boiling sounds these 24 hours
 Lat-33° 48' S
 Long 5° 10' E

Remarks on board Sunday Dec 10th
 Commenced with fresh breezes from N steering
 E, S, E, at 3 P.M. saw a dead sperm whale
 took him a long side blasted head commenced
 cutting and tore out middle part light rains
 Latter foggy at 6 cut from the whale could
 not rob him cleared up the decks sounds
 these 24 hours Lat-34° 06' S Long 5° 41' E

Remarks on board Monday Dec 11th
 Commenced with light breezes from N steering
 E saw Fin backs at night light rains
 middle part rain Latter light winds
 and foggy. Took out Flour Sugar &c
 sounds these 24 hours Lat-33° 20' S
 Long 7° 30' E

Remarks on board Tuesday Dec 12th
 Commenced with light breezes N steering S by E
 saw Whalers and Fin backs middle part calm
 Latter light breezes with heavy rains saw
 whight whales toward the Boats and galloped
 then came in Board at 8. Toward again
 with out success sounds these 24 hours
 Lat- Long 3

Remarks on board Wednesday Dec 13th
 Commenced with heavy squalls reefed top sails
 at 3. shook out reef again plenty of Fin backs
 in sight at night shortened sail for weather
 middle part fresh breezes Latter the same
 Employed in baking out Bread and water
 put the oil below sounds these 24 hours
 Lat 34° 17' S Long 9° 00' E
