Commenced with strong breezes from S.W.
Employed in repairing Bree at 4 P.M.
Saw a Right Whale going quick to windward
Hillers after the middle part fine latter
the same Employed in breaking out boards
sounds then 24 hours. Lat 36.13 Long 8.33 E

Remarks on board Friday Dec 15th
Commenced with light breezes from S.W.
Steering E.S.E. Saw Finbacks at night shore
Sail middle part fine weather Lat part light rain
Saw a Right Whale toward two boats and seized
his cane on board sounds then 24 hours
spoke ship. Buntle of Ben Bay Lat 35.36 Long 9.30 E

Remarks on board Saturday Dec 16th
Commenced with rain at 3 P.M. cleared off fine
weather two sails in sight at 5 P.M. saw a whale
toward at 6 struck at dark cut from his
dunnage fast to windward came on board
middle light breeze latter part light air at 9 A.M.
saw a Right Whale toward the boats and gave
chase sounds then 24 hours. Lat 35.39 Long 10.02 E

Remarks on board Sunday Dec 17th
Commenced with a calm at 3 P.M. boats came
on board whale out of sight middle light air
latter the same saw Finbacks sounds then
24 hours Lat 35.39 S Long 11.24 E

Remarks on board Monday Dec 18th
Commenced with light air from R.R.W. steering S.E.
saw Finbacks middle and later part fine
weather Employed in repairing Jell saw
Finbacks sounds then 24 hours.

Lat 37.00 S
Long 12.16 E

Remarks on board Tuesday Dec 17th
Commenced with light breezes and foggy
at 4 P.M. spoke ship. Three Brothers
of New Bedford 30 Spin 15.0. Whale
middle part latter the same a sail sign
sounds then 24 hours Lat 37.40 S Long 12.30 E

Remarks on board Wednesday Dec 18th
Commenced with fresh breezes from R.R.W.
Steering E by S saw Finbacks at night took
in light sails middle part fine weather
latter part strong breezes from S.W. steering
S.E. saw nothing of note sounds then 24 hours
Lat 37.44 S Long 14.30 E

Remarks on board Thursday Dec 19th
Commenced with strong breezes from S.E.
Steering S.E. by E. at night moderate
middle part calm latter light breezes from R.W.
steering S.E. by E. Employed in repairing Fore & Sail
sounds then 24 hours. Lat 37.30 S
Long 16.42 E

Remarks on board Friday Dec 20th
Commenced with fresh breezes from R.W. steering
S.E. by E Employed in breaking out water
at night took in Bow Boat saw Finbacks
middle strong breezes from R.R.W. steering S.E.
latter part blowing a gale sounds then
24 hours Lat 37.36 S Long 19.55 E

Remarks on board Saturday Dec 21st
Commenced with a gale from R.W. steering
S.E. by E at 3 P.M. close reefed main top sail
and took in fore top sail middle blowing a gale
loosing two under close reef main top sail
latter more moderate at 10 A.M. kept off and
made sail steering S.E. by E sounds then
24 hours Lat 38.02 S Long 20.12 E
