Commenced with strong breezes from S^W
steering S E by E made all sail broke out
meat & melasses middle part calm latter
light airs from N^W steering S E by E at sail
in light sounds these 24 hours. Lat 38.17 S
Long 21.33 E

Remarks onboard Monday Dec 25th
Commenced with light breezes from N^W steering S E by E
saw Pinbacks. Middle part fresh breezes
with rain from N^W steering S E by E took in
light sails latter moderate made up sail
sounds these 24 hours Lat 38.17 S
Long 25.02 E

Remarks onboard Tuesday Dec 26th
Commenced with fresh breezes from N^W steering
S E by E saw nothing of note middle part
light breezes from N^W latter part wind from
W^N steering S E by E sounds these 24 hours
Lat 38.23 S Long 27.57 E

Remarks onboard Wednesday Dec 27th
Commenced with light breezes from N^W steering
S E by E saw nothing of note middle part light
breezes from W^N latter part light airs
from S E. Employed in drawing & knotting gear
sounds these 24 hours. Lat 38.26 S Long 29.33 E

Remarks onboard Thursday Dec 28th
Commenced with light breezes from E heading
S E by E at 9 AM wind heaved in N^W steering S E by E
Employed in repairing fore sail middle
part blowing a gale took in sail at 5 AM
have two under close reef main top sail heavy squalls
from N^W. at 8 kept off again steering S E by E set
fore sail and reef fore top sail sounds these 24 hours
Lat 38.33 S Long 33.33 E

Remarks onboard Friday Dec 29th
Commenced with a gale from N^W steering S E by E
at 4 PM close reefed main top sail and took in
fore top sail heavy squalls. at 8 PM took fore sail
and have two middle part blowing a heavy gale.
latter more moderate at 11 AM made sail
and kept off steering S E. sounds these
24 hours Lat 38.34 S Long 35.33 E

Remarks onboard Saturday Dec 30th
Commenced with strong breezes from N^W
steering S E made all sail. Middle part
light breezes from N^W latter part fresh
breezes from N^W steering S E by E sounds
these 24 hours Lat Long

Remarks onboard Sunday Dec 31th
Commenced with strong breezes from N^W
steering S E by E employed in making and
water at 5 PM took in light sails at 7 PM
top sails middle part at 11 close reefed
main top sail and have two blowing a gale
from N^W latter part moderate with heavy
rain sounds these 24 hours. Lat Long

Remarks onboard Monday January 1st
Commenced with light breezes from N^W
steering S E by E middle part light breezes
from W to N^W. latter part the same
employed in fitting rigging sounds these
24 hours Lat 38.39 S Long 46.38 E
