Sunday May 11th
This day Strong S. winds & clear weather.

Monday May 12th
This day Calm cutting flood.

Tuesday May 13th
This day S. winds with some rain.

Wednesday May 14th
This day N. winds & showers of rain getting
off flood & water, all ready for sea tomorrow

Thursday May 15th
This day N. winds & strong weather for
to wind to get out

Friday May 16th
This day begins with light S. winds & calm
at 8 A.M. & rain & with some towing passed
through the passage, of the heads & heavy swell
& no wind & strong at 4 took A strong breeze from N.W.

Saturday May 17th
This day Strong W. wind & squalls of rain
steering N.

Sunday May 18th
This day A gale from S. with heavy squalls
of hail. Saw abundance of whales working S.
Lat 44.3 50 miles from land.

Monday May 19th
This day A gale from S.W. laying too

Tuesday May 20th
This day A heavy breeze from S.W.
Lat 43.38.

Wednesday May 21st
This day A gale from S.W.
Lat 44.3 Land in sight at 50 or 60 miles

Thursday May 22nd
This day fresh S.W. winds Lat 44.5 Long ---

Friday May 23rd
First report of this day Calm
at eight P.M. Saw 3 Whales going South like
the Steamer boat, toward but did not see them
again after for light air from S.
