Tuesday May 27
This day A gale from N.E. & strong. Laying to,

Wednesday June 2nd
X off Break Sea Land 15 miles.
from land. Saw several large Whales & took one
by the boat. Weather fair part of the day. Thick
at 4 P.M. with some rain. Latter part Calm &
more fine. at 7 P.M. took the whale along
side & hooked and strong breeze from S. which
freshened to A gale, could do nothing Cutting, so ended.

Thursday June 3
X A moderate gale from S. at daybreak hooked
on & tried to cut, but could do nothing. at 1
hooked on again, broke the lubber hook & gave it up.

Friday May 4th
X This day fresh E. winds. at 3 A.M. Commenced
Cutting. Shovel Packed & Cutting forward & back came
down with a crash. but fortunately without hurting
any one seriously. at 3 finished Cutting.
Lat 44.22, Cousins

Saturday June 5th
X This day Strong W. N. W. wind, & rugged weather.
at daylight saw a Whale near the ship. & landed. B. boat
struck. I lost 20 feet, whale landed & took all
this line & went of 10 minutes out of sight.
Saw several whales, appeared to head Home.
Lat 44.34 65 miles off.

Sunday June 6th
X This day Strong W. S. W. wind & squally
bailing. Spoke & gained with Ship Hunter 350 lbs
this season. Lat 44 22

Monday June 7th
X Strong Westly wind finished bailing. during
the night A gale, blew away fore staysail.

Tuesday June 8th
X This day Strong Westly wind, & barometer weather.
Lat 44.18

Wednesday June 9th
X This day Strong Westly wind & squally
weather.

Thursday June 10
X This day Strong N. W. wind & squally
weather. Stopped down.

Friday June 11
X This day A gale from N. & squally.

Saturday June 12
X Variable wind and same rain. Ends with S.
winds, & more fine
