July 4 S. winds & fine

Friday July 5
Strong S. winds at 10 saw Whales
boats went over them & galleyed them.
Lat 44° 15' 166

Saturday July 6
Strong S. winds & rugged at 10 A.M. saw Whales
saw W. Boat struck. Whale sounded and her crew
& went off to windward Lat 43° 50' Sang 168 110

Sunday July 7
Moderate South winds & fine weather.
Lat 44° 17' Sang 166 20

Monday July 8
Moderate S winds & calms

Wednesday July 9
Moderate N. winds spoke & gained with
H. Chartman Saphire 6 months out 30th Lat 44° 24' 165° 30'

Thursday July 10
Moderate N. winds & fine weather at 10 A.M.
saw B.K. Saphire whaling at 11 saw an whale
& lowered the boats. Chased him all day in Camp saw
with the Saphire boats but without success.
Lat 44° 25' Sang 165° 15'

Friday July 11th
This day moderate N. winds &
fine weather at 10 A.M. saw Whales lowered
& took an egg. W. Boat saw a good many large
Whales marking S. William gifford in light whaling
but did not get any. Lat 44° 30'

Saturday July 12
Moderate N. winds & fine weather finished cutting
& came sailing spoke & gained with Bark W.
Gifford 46 months out 1000 Whales & 1000 sperm.
Lat 44° 50'

Sunday July 13
Strong N.W. winds sailing Lat 45°

Monday July 14
This day fresh N. winds whaling Lat 45° 50'

Tuesday July 15th
This day light E. & S.E. winds & calms seen
the head and down in the glass - did finished
sailing Lat 45° 15'
