Moderate Boffing winds

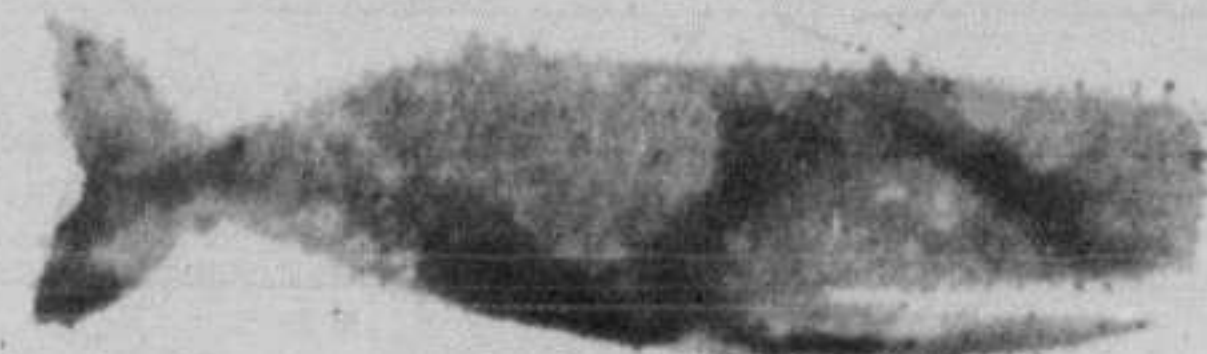

Fresh N. wind & thick weather,

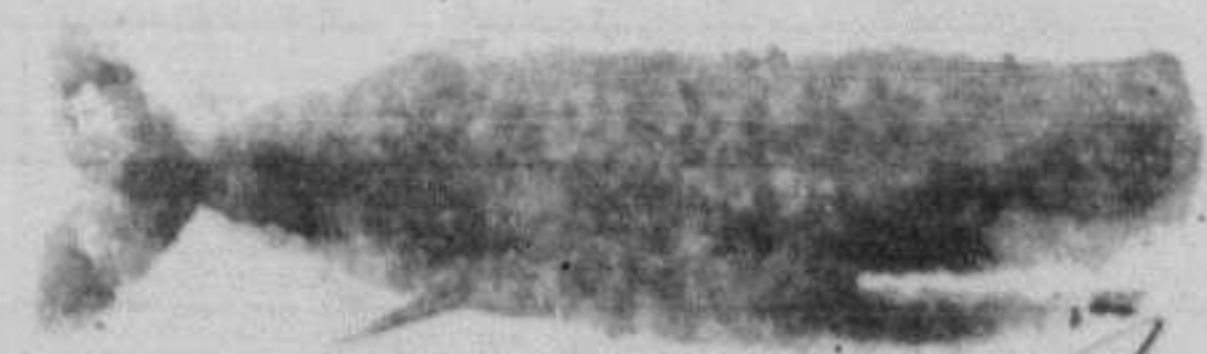
Friday Jan 2

and William Angles in 3rd office,

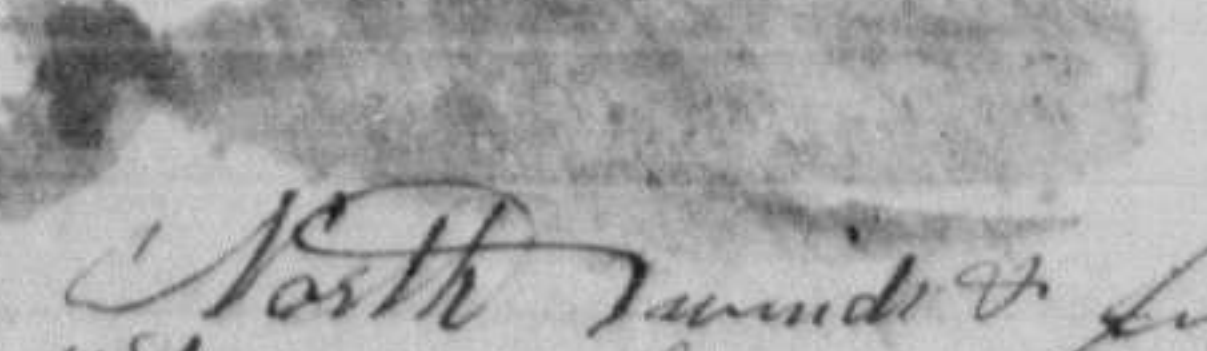


Sunday Jan 4th 1863.
At 3: A.M. saw whale, landed & took two
Pyramid bearing N.W. by W. dist 18 miles.
Can cutting weather fine, saw about
A dozen Whales, no other ship took whales,

Whale was also taken on the 15. also on the 8 of this
month by other ships.



May 7th 1863.
Cruised the off the West Coast of New Zealand
from April 1st until May 7th, when we saw our first
Whale, and took an in Lat. 44 45 Long 166. 0.
and ship cruising here during the past three months
have seen but a very few, if any whales.



Saturday May 7th
North wind & fine weather at 11 A.M. saw
Whale, being quick to windward they hooked and
had drenched. Bark Flying Childer, Addisam,
and Steptand in sight & whaling.
