

Monday June 25th, 1866.

Moderate S. winds & foggy weather.
Ship by the wind on S tack, Capt. W. H. Waller,
San Bark Harrison of San Francisco.

Tuesday June 26th.

S.E. winds & foggy weather, working W. along the S. edge
of the lee, at 4 P.M. Ledge Cape Behring 10 bars
W. N. W. dist 20 miles.

Wednesday June 27th.

All this day light S.E. winds spoke & gained
with ship Janus, Capt. Smith, at foggy most of the
day off the lee.

Thursday June 28th.

Calm, with more or less fog of Plover Bay, gained with
B. K. Briggs & S. Janus.

Friday June 29th.

All this day light air, from S.E. steering westward
but do not go any an amount of the ~~steering~~ setting
Eastward through the straits ship off Plover Bay,
Spoke ship Janus, at 11 P.M. saw ship Arnolda
& Bark Martha at anchor in Plover Bay, stood in & anchored
thick & rainy, calm.

Saturday June 30th.

At 11 got underway, beating west with light W.S.W.
winds, much ice in sight bearing from 100 to 120 miles clear
water next to the land, this day in clear.

Sunday June 30th.

At 1 P.M. came at anchor in Plover Bay after 12 hours
beating without gaining a foot, ship at anchor here
Arnolda, Martha, John Wells, Alpha, Illinois, & Normany
At 9 P.M. wind W.S.W. fresh, & foggy.

Monday July 1st.

At anchor in Plover Bay, thick fog sun, S.W.
saw the ship at anchor here.

Tuesday July 2nd.

Calm & foggy, at anchor in Plover Bay. Bark President
came in from gulph of Holy Cross, report many ships doing
well, Bark Daniel, Wood, & French ship, Winslow, stood
by the ice.

Wednesday July 3rd.

Thick fog at anchor in Plover Bay.

Thursday July 4th.

Foggy at anchor in Plover Bay.

Friday July 5th.

At anchor in Plover Bay thick fog.

Saturday July 6th.

At 11 A.M. got underway & stood to the W.
with a moderate S.W. wind & clear weather & other
ships in company.

Sunday July 7th.

Moderate W. winds working West, saw 11 ships
in the ice between Cape Agassiz & Plover Bay, working E.

Monday July 8th.

Moderate S.W. winds working W. along the lee.

Tuesday July 9th.

Calm & light variable air.

Wednesday July 10th.

Moderate S.W. winds & Calms, working W. Ends foggy.
