Off St. Carlos. 30 miles

& did not get fast. & that is our days work.



Jan 18th
Saw S. whales at 2 P.M.
Calm. Killed them. W. boat dived at one
then blowed up boatster with darting gun,
bomb through his neck.
Lat 40-50 50 miles from
land

Jan 21
Anchored at Mocha at 11 A.M.
got underweigh at 6 P.M. got nothing.
Potatoes will not be ripe before the latter part
of Feb. no letters

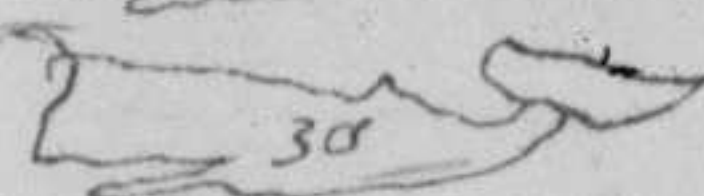

Saw whales at 6 A.M.
going S. lowered but got nothing it being calm.
Lat 37.25 S. 15 miles from land. At 6. saw more
whales going S. lowered, got nothing. Lat 37-15 S. 15 miles off.
4000 whales.

(Palahuanos)

Anchored at Palahuanos Jan 25th.
found no opportunity to ship oil. Sold 10224 half whale oil
at 50. 1273 gall sperm oil at \$1.00 per gall. U.S. gold.
Sailed on the 7th of Feb. for the N. Lost 17 men by
desertion Caught 6 of them



March 2 1882
Saw a school of whales at 10 A.M.
took 2. W. & L. boats. 3000 whales. Cut in.
Lat 5:00 N. Long 110 W.

ARCTIC

March 29th 1882
Sailed from Honolulu for Arctic Ocean.

April 18th Passed through 4 of islands.

X April 27. Did not meet with any ice until
half way between Cape Thaddeus & Plover Bay.
S.E. gale. Saw 2 sail. in the night. thick smoky
weather. Rigging was up bad.

April 29. Rained with the Hidalgo & Atlantic.
& N. Star. Saw the S. & Susan. a number of
ships have taken whales. the John H. Arnold &
up to the keel in Lat 64-15 Long 177-45 W.
