

Sunday Dec 14th 1845.

This day commenced with strong wind from E with rain middle part fine weather made sail. latter part one ship in sight to weather double reefed the topsails. so ends today.

Monday Dec 14th 1845.

This day commenced with strong wind and fine weather. watch at work blowing off the sun and so ends today.

Tuesday Dec 15th 1845.

This day commenced with strong wind from S E. Course close to wind one sail in sight a 3 mast a schooner watch at work mending sails so ends today.

Wednesday Dec 17th 1845.

This day commenced with dead calm and fine weather. settled down topsails watch at work mending main topsail latter part light wind hoisted topsails & topgallant sail wind N. Course S E. so ends today.

Thursday Dec 18th 1845.

This day commenced with light wind from N. Course S E watch at work making spun yarn knotting & drawing yarn. so ends today.

Friday Dec 20th 1845.

This day commenced with dead calm middle part settled down topsails. latter part hoisted them again wind from N W. Course S E. E. sent down fore topgallant yard.

Saturday Dec 21st 1845.

This day commenced with calm. watch at work making bone spun yarn & seeing stiff latter part light wind from N. Course S E. E. so ends today.

Sunday Dec 22nd 1845.

This day commenced with moderate wind from N. middle part still mending took in topgallant sails and double reefed the topsails put in mainsail and let latter part took in fore topsail fore sail and close reefed the main topsail set for spinnaker and topmast stay sail and love to heading N W. so ends today.

Monday Dec 23rd 1845.

This day commenced with a strong gale from N W. going to. at middle part moderated and made sail latter part set topgallant sails sent down the fore and main topgallant yards and lowered the royal masts. so ends today.

Tuesday Dec 24th 1845.

This day commenced with fine weather and calm latter part fastened  and got a sperm whale and got a rainy weather and commenced cutting got him in and set the watch at 8 o'clock all hands at 6 and commenced boiling and clearing away head so ends today.

Wednesday Dec 25th

All hands boiling and clearing up decks and fine weather and light wind from N. so ends today.
