

Jan 8 This day commences with fresh breezes from the N. Caught 200 groupers. Sunset clear. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$. Light breezes from the N.

Jan 9 This day commences with fresh breezes from the N.W. Caught 190 groupers. Sunset clear. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 10 This day commences with strong breezes from the S.W. At 9 A.M. made sail for the reef and at 4 P.M. anchored at Bulls Bank. Sunset cloudy. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 11 This day commences with fresh breezes from the N. Sailed across the reef and tried fishing. Caught 20. Sunset light breezes from the E. Anchored at Favius. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 12 This day commences with fresh breezes from the E.S.E. Got underway at sunrise and at 5 P.M. anchored at Loggerhead. Clear. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 13 This day commences with fresh breezes from the E.E. At 9 A.M. arrived at Key West. At 4 P.M. started for Havana. At sunset anchored near Sand Key. Calm. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 14 This day commences with light breezes from the S.E. Caught 45 fish. At sunset calm. Sand Key bearing East distant 10 miles. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 15 This day commences calm. Caught 25 fish. Sunset calm. Sand Key bearing E. distant 12 miles. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 16 This day commences calm. At 11 A.M. a light breeze coming from the N. started for Havana. At sunset a light breeze from the N.E. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 17 This day commences with a light breeze from the N. At 3 P.M. anchored in Havana. Sunset strong breezes from the N. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 18 This day commences with strong breezes from the N. Weighed out 5965 lbs fish. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 19 Lying in Havana. Schooner "King of the Forest" in company. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 20 This day commences with strong breezes from the E. At daylight left Havana in company with schooner "King of the Forest". At 2 P.M. took a very heavy squall from the W. At 3 A.M. (21) anchored in Key West. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 21 This day commences with strong breezes from the S.W. Lying in Key West. At 12 M. hauled in to Wall's Wharf. Sunset clear. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 22 This day commences calm. Lying in Key West. Lined sails. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.

Jan 23 This day commences calm. At 12 M. got underway for the fishing grounds. Sunset calm. Barometer $29\frac{7}{10}$.
