

Southwestern Ocean Towards Cape Horn
Sept 30th

Tuesday. weather comes in pleasant and clear from the North east. sea smooth middle and latter hours fresh breezes vessels going quick. saw the first kelp this day. so ends
Lat in 37.47'S
Long near 54.36'W

October 1st Wednesday comes in moderate wind more westerly with ruffled sea middle and latter hours calm
Lat in 38.50'S
Long near 55.45'W

October 2nd commences moderate wind inclining southerly with smooth sea, one Brig. in sight heading southerly saw Penguin this day and kelp with many Biras, middle and latter hours wind freshens and freshens up day ends cloudy. wind North
Lat in 40.33'S
Long near 56.42'W

October 3rd Friday wind from the North and west. fresh with ugly cross sea running from the south & west first part middle more moderate breeze saw kelp this day and saw all the traps and Penguin latter part fresh breeze from the North West.
Lat in 42.40'S
Long near 59.27'W

October 4th comes in moderate inclining westerly with smooth sea carrying all sail heading SSW. middle and latter hours strong gales from the south west. Have two unsew Balamen keepee firsail and main trysails. This day we have had rain. Hail and snow in squalls. one Hermaphrodite Brig. here too with Stabonatacks on board heading N. West
Lat in 44.19'S
Long in 60.19'W

Towards Cape Horn Southern Ocean
Oct 5th Sunday comes in with strong gales from the WSW. schooner here too heading South. rough sea running little hours moderates and inclines Northward
Lat in 45.03'S
Long near 60.01'W

Oct 6th Monday wind North West and clear men employed filling water in the empty casks. Heavy decken the schooner is getting too light below for heavy weather middle and latter hours more moderate and pleasant, wind West
Lat in 47.12'S
Long near 62.21'W

Oct 7th Tuesday comes in fine and pleasant wind from the West with smooth sea schooner going quick continues through out the day.
Lat in 49.50'S
Long near 64.31'W

Oct 8th Wednesday commences more moderate and sky overcast. and weather cooler middle and latter part variable with some sea
Lat in 51.33'S
Long near 64.59'W

Oct 9th Thursday comes in moderate and variable steering South Distance to Staten Land two hundred miles middle and latter fresh breezes from the North West at 11 a.m. made Staten Land bearing South East. Dist. 63 miles
Lat in 54.01'S
Long near 65.00'W

Being very short of water, and wind westerly and light. I have deemed it judicious to make Port in Staten Land to obtain the needed supplies of wood and water. Having studied the best authorities and taken on the above question I have adopted them or accepted them
