

Brazil Coast

April 3rd Tuesday, continues moderate standing northerly, middle hours squally from the Eastward, latter hours made the land of the river Santa Cruz, distant about 12 miles Lat in $16^{\circ}48'S$ $00^{\circ}00'$

April 4th Saturday, calm weather with passing squalls of rain. Land of Laguna in sight caught some new grasses this day

April 5th Sunday squally with light baffling breeze all through the day and not saw a steamer Bona north in shore

Lat in $16^{\circ}10'S$ $38^{\circ}42'N$
Lat in $15^{\circ}07'S$ $11^{\circ}11'N$

April 6th Monday, pleasant, and wind light from Easterly going on course.

April 7th Tuesday, freshening breeze from the E & East, going on course, one brig in sight heading S West Lat in $11^{\circ}14'S$ $36^{\circ}10'N$

April 8th Wednesday, pretty much calm all this day with rain squalls, one bark and a brig in sight bearing northward

Lat in $10^{\circ}13'S$ $38^{\circ}37'N$
Moderate, with occasional squalls of rain land in sight and 1 bark 2 brigs working northward Lat in $9^{\circ}43'S$ $20^{\circ}00'N$

April 10th Friday heavy squally weather with ugly sea running no observation

April 11th Saturday weather clears up and wind comes south East, and pleasant sailing Lat in $7^{\circ}05'S$ $33^{\circ}57'N$

Of Lake St George Borne

April 12th Sunday, fine pleasant with East winds all this 24 hours, schooner going her course and quick Lat in $4^{\circ}00'S$ $34^{\circ}02'N$

April 13th Monday fresh breeze with rain squalls from the South East, also this 24 hours, schooner going quick, Lat in $1^{\circ}18'S$ $34^{\circ}52'N$

April 14th Tuesday, moderate with rain squalls all this day, wind easterly and sea ahead, Lat in $00^{\circ}18'N$ $35^{\circ}56'N$

April 15th Wednesday moderate with head sea all this 24 hours, passing squalls of rain Lat in $1^{\circ}45'N$ no observation

April 16th Thursday moderate easterly winds throughout this day and cloudy Lat in $3^{\circ}24'N$ $00^{\circ}00'N$

April 17th Friday moderate East & North variable winds, approaching calm Lat in $4^{\circ}07'N$ $38^{\circ}53'N$

April 18th moderate and pleasant throughout Lat in $5^{\circ}43'N$ $40^{\circ}48'N$

April 19th Sunday, first water moderate middle hours squally, latter hours moderate with rain no observation this day

April 20th Monday, strong North East Trade this day, cloudy weather, schooner going quick to West by North compass Lat in $9^{\circ}43'N$ $44^{\circ}40'N$

April 21st Tuesday, fresh North East Trades all this day inclining East and southerly with occasional squalls, Lat in $11^{\circ}50'N$ $46^{\circ}24'N$
at noon Declination was on latitude being directly overhead
