April 22^d Fresh and fair, with East trades,
with occasional squalls Lat $14.05^{\circ}N$ $49.21^{\circ}W$

April 23^d Thursday, fair and pleasant trades
schooner running well, employed painting
and otherwise cleaning ship Lat $16.10^{\circ}N$ $51.40^{\circ}W$

April 24th Friday, fresh and fair breezes, also
this 24 hours, occasional squalls.
Lat in $18.10^{\circ}N$ $54.10^{\circ}W$

April 25th Saturday, fine pleasant breezes also
this day, one sail in sight to seaward
Lat $20.21^{\circ}N$ $56.22^{\circ}W$

April 26th Sunday, clear and pleasant, wind light
from the East and South E Lat $22.07^{\circ}N$ $58.35^{\circ}W$

April 27th Monday, very still calm weather also this
day, three vessels in sight from a southerly
Lat in $22.58^{\circ}N$ $59.39^{\circ}W$

April 28th Tuesday, moderate with East winds
and head sea Lat in $23.58^{\circ}N$

April 29th Wednesday, light breezes with heavy
head sea, latter hours fresh, $24.11^{\circ}N$ $61.57^{\circ}W$

April 30th Thursday, with a fresh westerly
with head sea, latter hours moderates
Lat in $26.51^{\circ}N$ $64.16^{\circ}W$

May 1st Friday, moderate and squally wind
hauling northerly, with heavy head sea
latter hours pleasant wind with East
Lat in $27.52^{\circ}N$ $65.47^{\circ}W$

May 2^d Saturday, calm weather with heavy
squalls from the North West, also this
day, large quantities of Gulf Weed for
the last few days.
Lat in $27.56^{\circ}N$ $65.57^{\circ}W$

May 3^d Sunday moderate weather from the
South West, Lat in $29.06^{\circ}N$ $66.52^{\circ}W$

May 4th Monday, little wind, some rain and
much heavy head sea Lat in $31.02^{\circ}N$ $67.40^{\circ}W$

May 5th Tuesday, freshening breezes first part, passed
a lot of square timber and a ship's Binnacle
apparently but, little while in the water
latter hours strong winds with rain squalls
from the South West Lat in $33.33^{\circ}N$ $69.05^{\circ}W$

May 6th Wednesday, strong gales from the NW
and squalls, first and middle water,
latter hours wind veers to the North and East
moderate and Bca sea, Lat in $35.25^{\circ}N$ Long No. 2

May 7th Thursday, first part fresh breezes from
the North, latter hours moderate with
squalls, in the Gulf, Lat in $36.27^{\circ}N$ $70.39^{\circ}W$

May 8th Friday, moderate with some rain in
squalls in the Gulf, two sail in sight from
northerly Lat in $38.06^{\circ}N$ $69.21^{\circ}W$

May 9th Saturday, first part strong breezes from
the West & South West, left the Gulf 1 PM
latter hours moderate and hazy, three ships in sight
overcast, and hazy, three ships in sight
Lat in $40.12^{\circ}N$ $70.01^{\circ}W$

May 10th Sunday, strong breezes from the westward

midnight got a sound from 19 fathoms
sharp and water and pebbly bottom, judged it, coxens
