THOMAS HUNT

Second Voyage Same Schooner

- July 23rd Left Stonington this day wind moderate and pleasant throughout latter hours calm. Lat. $41.12. 71. 57$
- July 24th Calm still weather throughout this day many sail in sight Lat in $40.43N 70. 18W$
- July 25th Saturday. Still calm with occasional airs from the south and east, south shoals light in sight bearing north & east distant 10 miles three ocean steamers passed this day one westward & two easterly day was moderate from the south east no observations, or
- July 26th Sunday winds very light and buffling from the south and east all this day & pleasant Lat in $39.57 69. 38W$
- July 27th Monday moderate and pleasant this day working eastward 38.10
- July 28th Tuesday strong south wind and squally day was rough. $38.10 64.10W$
- July 29th Stebb Breezes from the south west and pleasant schooner going quick. Lat. in $38.12. 59. 37W$
- July 30th Thursday winds fresh and fair vessels going quick one ship steering eastward in sight. no observations
- July 31th Friday mild and pleasant from the south west Lat $38.10 57.18W$
- July August 1st Mild and pleasant throughout all these 24 hours. Lat in $38.09 48. 00W$

- Bona for southern Ocean & Islands
- Aug 2nd 3rd Sunday fine and pleasant throughout all these 24 hours. Lat in $38.19N 45.42W$
- Aug 2nd 3rd Monday calm still weather from the southern bore. vessel moving slow Lat in $38.34. 43. 03W$
- Aug 2nd 4th Tuesday the same calm weather all these 24 hours. Two Brigs in sight, one showing 13 Bays in Holland in flag & lumber loaded. Steady East. Lat in $39.16N 41. 25W$
- Aug 2nd 5th Wednesday being moderate still light air from the south first and middle watch latter hours glass calm Lat in $39.40N 40.41W$
- Aug 6th Thursday calm sea rolling from the westward first and middle watch. saw a large school of Blackfish close to five vessels in sight also drifting eastward men generally employed fitting boats and other ship duties. Day ends calm $39.37N 39. 35W$
- Aug 7th Friday calm weather throughout. Bunt set the square sail this day $39.25N 38. 25W$
- Aug 8th Saturday commences moderate light air from the westward and continues throughout. three square rigged vessels in sight bound eastward Lat in $39.42 37.05W$
- Aug 9th Sunday light air from the south east. Bounding calm and thus continues. four square rigged vessels in sight Bona Eastward latter part calm with smooth sea. Lat in $40.32 36. 05W$
