Aug 10th Monday first and middle water moderate from the south and East, latter hours freshening breezes from the East & East with head sea Lat. 39.50 N 34.55 W

Aug 11th Tuesday moderate with rain south East made the Island of Flores and arrived 10 m Bearing East North East distant 40 miles Day was moderate from Lat in 38.43 32.40 m

Aug 12th Wednesday. Be calmed off the Island of Flores all this 24 hours one schooner and Barkentine in sight 39.10 N 31.15 W

Aug 13th Thursday calm weather. Land seen this day at Santo Cruz on the Island of Flores Shipped ten men and purchased thirty bushels of Potatoes, and three thousand onions paying 80 cents for the first and 3 for the latter per thous. took the same on board and proceeded southward. Boat crew also drunk. Thus ends the day

Aug 14th Friday with light south and west first part. Middle and latter hours calm with smooth sea. Distributed clothing to additional crew shipped at Flores Lat in 37.44 N 30.44 W

Aug 15th Saturday calm still weather from the westward all this day. Lat in 37.02 N 30.00 W

Aug 16th Sunday increasing breezes from the north and west first water moderate and latter hours veers westerly saw one ship bearing westward and a Brig on our starboard Bow 35.26 N 30.06 W

Aug 17th Monday first and middle hours pleasant rain from the north and smooth sea latter hours squally with rain. No observation

Aug 18th Tuesday first and middle hours moderate with rain squalls. Latter hours calm and warm all hands employed fitting ship. Lat in 32.41 N 29.40 W

Aug 19th Wednesday. Calm still weather all the 24 hours. Lowered the Boat and picked up a cask having the appearance of a buoy. long drifting with shingles attached and marked M. Simer. Carlson & Company No observation

Aug 20th Thursday commences moderate continues throughout the first and middle water latter hours gentle North East trades with smooth sea Lat in 30.34 N 30.04 W

Aug 21th Friday moderate North East trades all this day some southern squalls Lat 28.29 N 30.13 W

Aug 22th Saturday fresh North East trades and rough sea strong S by West 28.34 N 29.48 W

Aug 23th Sunday moderate with E winds with white fleecy flying clouds. smooth sea Lat in 28.13 N 29.05 W

Aug 24th Monday light baffling winds from the eastern board Lat in 27.22 N 28.54 W

Aug 25th Tuesday freshening breezes from the eastern board with rain squalls. Strong south by west. Picked a bark strong north Lat in 18.37 28.28 W
