

South Atlantic Ocean Brazil coast

Sept 8th

Tuesday strong south east trades and squally with rugged heavy sea. one ship and Brig in sight. Both heading southward
Lat in $8^{\circ} 44'S$ $30.36^{\circ}W$

Sept 9th

Wednesday moderates and grows smoother with clearing weather first and middle watch. one ship in sight. latter hours moderate and pleasant Lat $10^{\circ} 54'S$ $32.16^{\circ}W$

Sept 10th

Thursday. wind from the S East and heavy squalls first and middle watch latter hours moderate and rough sea
Lat in $12^{\circ} 54'S$ $33.51^{\circ}W$

Sept 11th

Friday. moderate breeze with squalls from the eastern board. latter hours fresh and pleasant
Lat in $14^{\circ} 04'S$ $36.41^{\circ}W$

Sept 12th

Saturday strong breeze first and middle watch. latter hours veers northward with rough sea squalls going quick Lat in $17^{\circ} 36'S$ $37.06^{\circ}W$

Sept 13th

Sunday. continues fair and pleasant, from the north East. already Abrolhos Islands Brazil coast latter hours strong winds and more northerly
Lat in $20^{\circ} 11'S = 37.38^{\circ}W$

Sept 14th

Monday. comes in fresh breeze from the northward saw a small shoal of black fish and one fin back whale. middle hours fresh breeze squalls going quick. latter hours squally and falls of calm Lat in $22^{\circ} 05'S$ $38.47^{\circ}W$

Sept 15th

Tuesday continues calm with high rolling choppy sea from the south West. middle hours light airs from the north East and rough sea latter hours fresh breeze from the N East and rugged Lat in $23^{\circ} 05'S$ $39.13^{\circ}W$

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Sept 16th

Wednesday first and middle fresh breeze from the eastward with high sea from the south West. two Barks in sight. one steering north the other for Rio Janeiro. latter hours strong gales. saw the first pigeon this day 25.30° $41.31^{\circ}W$

Sept 17th

Thursday. calm and rugged all these 24 hours saw a shoal of Whales. I think might feeding one ship in sight Lat $27^{\circ} 05'S$ $42.39^{\circ}W$

Sept 18th

Friday. calm this day. instead of the above which is an error. latter hours breeze from the north West clear and pleasant $27^{\circ} 56'S$ $42.51^{\circ}W$
Four square rigged vessels in sight bound north

Sept 19

Saturday. moderate breeze from the north West first watch. middle and latter hours calm. one Brig in sight bound south. and numerous south sea birds around the schooner Lat in $38^{\circ} 41'S$ $43.38^{\circ}W$

Sept 20th

Sunday variable. squalls. calms and high jumbled up sea all this 24 hours
Lat in $30.21'S$ $44.47^{\circ}W$

Sept 21st

Monday. first watch high crooked sea. and calm clear weather. middle hours squalls from the Eastward. latter hours fresh from the Northeast and clearing
Lat in 31.57° 47.36°

Sept 22

Tuesday. continues with freshening breeze from the north and east. middle hours. heavy gales. violent and threatening weather. continues frequently and fearfully throughout latter hours hauls more north with high sea. Ripped a Bark home to under storm sails Lat in $34.10'S$ Long $50.20^{\circ}W$
