Monday 31st

First and Middle part Strong Gales and a heavy swell sent down the Fore and Mizzen top Gallant yards, at 4 a.m. set the Fore and Mizzen top sails at 7 a.m. out two reefs of the topsails and set the main sail Strong breeze from the N.W.

Tuesday 1st November 1836.

First part Strong breezes at 6 P.M. hauled the Main sail at 8 P.M. Clos'd reef'd the Top sails at 10 P.M. hauled the Fore top sail Middle part Strong Gales attended with hard Squalls at 2 a.m. hauled the Fore sail at 8 a.m. set it again, weather more moderate

Wednesday 2nd

Commences with Strong breezes and variable Middle and latter part Moderate and fine weather Course N.W.

Lat by Obs. 35. 20 S.

Thursday 3rd

First part light breezes attended with passing Showers of Rain Middle part thick hazy weather Latter part fair till 11 a.m. then commenced a Gale took in sail and hove her too

Lat by Obs. 35. 50 S.

Friday 4th November 1836.

Lying too till daylight, made sail and staid West Latter part Moderate weather,

Saturday 5th

Commences with light airs and variable at 3 P.M. wore ship and staid N.W. Middle and Latter part Strong breezes from N.W. by N.

Lat by Obs 35. 41 S.

Sunday 6th

First part light airs and variable

Middle part Squally with Showers of rain

Latter part light breezes and clear weather

Lat by Obs. 35. 50 S.

Monday 7th

Commences with Strong breezes from S.W. Course S.W. by W. Middle and Latter part fresh breezes and clear weather at noon set the Fore topmast and main top Gallant Studding sails,

First part fine Moderate breeze, Middle and Latter part Strong Gales from N.W. Course S.W.

Lat by Obs. 37. 45 S.

Wednesday 9th

First and Middle part Strong breezes Latter part Moderate and hazy weather
