

Tuesday 29th

First part strong breezes and a heavy swell from the Westward at 6 P.M. wore ship headed N by W. heavy weather with some little rain. Middle part strong breezes and variable at 2 a.m. wore ship headed N by N. closed reefed Fore top sail at 9 a.m. handed it strong Gales. Attended with hail Squalls. Lat by Obs. 56.23 S

Wednesday 30th

Commences with strong Gales from S.W. course West. set the Fore top sail headed N by N. at 10 a.m. out one reef Fore top sail set Jib and Spanker. Moderate weather at 6 a.m. Stead N.W. winds from N by E. heavy weather. Lat by Obs. 55.0 S.

Thursday 1st December 1836.

First part moderate weather with rain winds from Northward and Eastward course N.W. all drawing sail set. Middle part strong breezes. Attended with Squalls double reefed the Top sails. Latter more Moderate. Lat by Obs. 53.59 S.

Friday 2nd

Commences with calm and clear weather at 3 P.M. an increasing breeze from N.E. at 7 P.M. double reefed Fore top sail single reefed main and mizen handed main sail set the Spencers. at 1 a.m. took in all sail to a closed reef main top sail and hove her to headed S.W. at 5 a.m. handed it blew a heavy Gale throughout. Lat by Obs. 53.30 S.

Saturday 3rd

Weather more Moderate set the top sails closed reefed at 4 P.M. wore ship headed N by W. set the Fore sail, reefed the Main sail and set it out one reef top sails set the main top Gallant sail, Middle and Latter part fresh breezes from N by S. Lat by Obs. 52.7 S.

Sunday 4th

First part strong breezes. Middle more Moderate and heavy weather at 10 a.m. an increasing breeze wore ship headed N by S. Lat. by Obs. 50.29 S.

Monday 5th

First part strong breezes at 1 P.M. in 2nd Reef Fore and Main top sails at 2 P.M. took in Spanker and Jib at 3 P.M. handed the Main sail at 5 P.M. closed reefed Fore and Mizen top sails, heavy weather attended with heavy Squalls of Rain. at 6 P.M. handed Fore and Mizen top sails and closed reefed the main, reefed the Fore sail and set it. at 2 A.M. set the Fore and Mizen top sails closed reefed strong breezes throughout no Observation. Lat by Obs. 50.47 S.

Tuesday 6th

At 1 P.M. weather more Moderate wore ship made sail headed N by W. Winds from Westward Fair weather throughout these 24 hours. Lat by Obs. 49.24 S.
